<u>How do I get there?</u> Make your best way to Foxwoods Resort and Casino, and take the Fox Tower exit on Route 2, parking in the garage. There is a map on the next page of how to get from the garage to the sign in table in front of the ballroom.

<u>Can my kids come?</u> Probably- This ballroom will be like a construction zone, with LOTS of tripping hazards, and moving heavy equipment as this huge show breaks down. Children under the age of 16 must be next to their legal guardians at all times, and we reserve the right to request volunteers we feel are unsafe to stay helping only at the sign in table.

Does this count for required community services hours? Yes! At the sign in table we have someone that will sign any required forms, and will also give out certificates to children (of all ages when requested).

<u>I can't lift heavy things, can I help?</u> Yes! We can always use volunteers at the sign in table, taking pictures, and packing light weight items like paper plates and spices into boxes for others to move onto the pallets.

How will I know what to do? At the sign table we will give you a quick brief, and in the room we can pair you with an experienced volunteer.

<u>I can't be there the whole time, is that ok?</u> Yes! Whether you have 15 minutes to volunteer, or two hours, many hands make for light work. How late we will be there depends entirely on how many volunteers come to help.
